COUNT 1

MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, as Prosecuting Attorney for the State of Florida in the County of Broward, by and through his undersigned Assistant State Attorney, charges that beginning on or about December 9, 2002, and continuing through on or about August 14, 2006, inclusive, in the County and State aforesaid, the defendant, EVELINE R. WRIGHT, did then and there did engage in a scheme to defraud; to-wit: utilized operating funds of The Preserve at Chapel Trail Homeowners Association, Inc., to pay personal bills, whereby the said Eveline R. Wright did obtain property of an aggregate value of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) or more; to-wit: money, from The Preserve at Chapel Trail Homeowners Association, Inc., or others, contrary to Section 817.034(4)(a)1, Florida Statutes.

COUNT 2

MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, as Prosecuting Attorney for the State of Florida in the County of Broward, by and through his undersigned Assistant State Attorney, charges that beginning on or about December 9, 2002, and continuing through on or about August 14, 2006, inclusive, pursuant to one scheme or course of conduct, in the County and State aforesaid, the defendant, **EVELINE R. WRIGHT**, did then and there unlawfully and knowingly obtain or use, or endeavor to obtain or use, the property of The Preserve at Chapel Trail Homeowners Association, Inc., to-wit: money, of the value of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) or more, but less than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00), with the intent to either temporarily or permanently deprive The Preserve at Chapel Trail Homeowners Association, Inc., of a right to the property or benefit from the property, or to appropriate the property to her own use or to the use of any person not entitled to the use of the property, contrary to Sections 812.014(1)(a), 812.014(1)(b) and 812.014(2)(b)1, Florida Statutes.

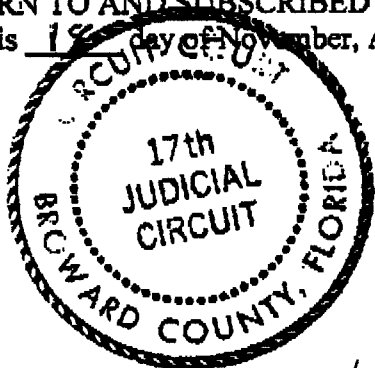
